**ON THE DAY:** Team Managers will be required to declare their team on arrival, and **not later than 30 minutes before the start of the class**, using the official Declaration Forms supplied by BRC HQ. Each horse will be checked against the Flu Vaccination Certificate brought with the competitor. Any horse with a certificate found to be incorrect may be allowed to enter H.C. at the discretion of the Official Steward. There will be a tack inspection.

**PARKING:** PLEASE park with care, taking only the minimum space. As the parking area is limited, **we would be grateful if you could do your test and go home!** The last competitor of each team may stay to collect awards and sheets for all 4 team members.

**SAFETY:** No horse is to be left unattended while tied to any vehicle.  
No Smoking is allowed on campus.  
No dogs are allowed on campus.  
Please ensure that all droppings, spilt hay and litter are placed in the receptacles provided.

**PLEASE NOTE:**

- 1 British Riding Clubs 2009 rules apply to all classes.
- 2 Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor British Riding Clubs, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must in turn take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and their officials and stewards.
- 3 All riders must wear hard hats when mounted. We recommend hats to PAS015 or BS EN1384 or a superior standard. Hats marked ASTM are also acceptable.
- 4 No misuse of whips or spurs is allowed. With the exception of boots, which must be removed before entering the arena, horses must be warmed up in the tack in which they will compete.
- 5 Any objection must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not substantiated.
- 6 Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear of horse areas and to avoid behaviour which might alarm horses. No dogs are permitted on the Campus except Guide Dogs.
- 7 "Senior" includes all competitors aged 18 or over on 1st January 2010. "Junior" includes all competitors aged 17 or under on 1st January 2010.
