SENDING BY JANUARY 28th 2012. IF SHE DOES NOT HEAR FROM YOUR CLUB BY THIS
DATE, SHE WILL ASSUME THAT YOU ARE NOT SENDING ANY SENIOR TEAMS AND
WILL ALLOCATE YOUR CLUB'S TWO TEAMS PLACES TO CLUBS WHO HAVE ASKED
TO ENTER MORE THAN 2 TEAMS

(Please note that Preliminary entries on the official forms must
arrive at BRC HQ, Stoneleigh, by Friday 3rd February 2012.
Only full members who have been declared to BRC HQ by this
date are eligible to compete.)

ON THE DAY: Team Managers will be required to declare their team on arrival,
and **not later than 30 minutes before the start of the class**,
using the official Declaration Forms supplied by BRC HQ.
Each horse will be checked against the Flu Vaccination
Certificate **brought with the competitor**. Any horse with a
certificate found to be incorrect may be allowed to enter H.C. at
the discretion of the Official Steward. There will be a tack and
dress inspection. If you are unsure of any tack or dress rules
please check with your club, BRC or the organiser **before** the
day.

PARKING: Please park with care. The last competitor of each team may
stay to collect awards and sheets for all 4 team members.

SAFETY: No horse is to be left unattended while tied to any vehicle.
No Smoking inside the indoor arena building.
Dogs must be kept on leads.
Please ensure that all droppings, spilt hay and litter are placed in
the receptacles provided.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1 British Riding Clubs 2012 rules apply to all classes.
- 2 Save for death or personal injury caused by the negligence of the organisers or anyone for whom they are in law responsible, neither the organisers of the event to which these rules apply, nor British Riding Clubs, nor the British Horse Society, nor any agent, employee or representative of these bodies accepts any liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land, vehicles, their contents and accessories or any other person or property whatsoever, whether caused by their negligence, breach of contract or in any other way whatsoever. The organisers have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective everyone must in turn take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organisers and their officials and stewards.
- 3 **All riders must wear hard hats when mounted. Acceptable hats are PAS015 or BS EN1384. Please see dress guidelines appendices in rulebook on BRC website. Hats will be checked and tagged on the day if they have not already been.**
- 4 No misuse of whips or spurs is allowed. With the exception of boots, which must be removed before entering the arena, horses must be warmed up in the tack in which they will compete.
- 5 Any objection must be made in writing within 30 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit which will be forfeited if the objection is not substantiated.
- 6 Horses can easily be frightened and can be dangerous. Members of the public are requested to keep clear of horse areas and to avoid behavior which might alarm horses. "Senior" includes all competitors aged 18 or over on 1st January 2012. "Junior" includes all competitors aged 17 or under on 1st January 2012.
